FISCAL REVIEW: There are 41 property owners in Shiloh Downs as of July 1, 2016. Fifteen lots are currently available.

Delinquent Accounts: As of July 1, 2016 the amount of \$18.168.00 owed to the HOA in delinquent accounts. Please keep in mind that if you would like to see the community continue to grow and develop, EVERYONE is expected to pay their dues by due date. Payments are due each April and September with a \$25 late fee accessed each month if not paid. Dues are used for neighborhood improvements, ground maintenance, street improvements and also for special projects to improve the community such as improving the aesthetics of the

front gate entrance and cleaning/restocking the fish ponds. If you would like to recommend projects to improve the community send sd.hoa.redoak@gmail.com.
